carlos fuentes 1928 2012 was the most prominent novelist in contemporary mexico and until his recent death one of the leading voices in latin america s boom generation he received the most prestigious awards and prizes in the world including the latin civilization award presented by the presidents of brazil mexico and france the miguel de cervantes prize and the prince of asturias award during his fecund and accomplished life as a writer literary theorist and political analyst fuentes turned his attention to the major conflicts of the twentieth century from the second world war and the cuban revolution to the soviet invasion of czechoslovakia the war in vietnam and the post revolutionary crisis of the one party rule in mexico and attended to their political and international importance in his novels short fiction and essays known for his experimentation in narrative techniques and for novels and essays written in a global range that illuminate the conflicts of our times fuentes s writings have been rightfully translated into most of the world s languages his literary work continues to spur and provoke the interest of a global readership on diverse civilizations and eras from imperial spain and post revolutionary france to ancient and modern mexico the united states and latin america the reptant eagle essays on carlos fuentes and the art of the novel includes nineteen essays and one full introduction written exclusively for this volume by renowned fuentes scholars from asia europe the united states and latin america collected into five parts the essays integrate wide ranging methods and innovative readings of the death of artemio cruz 1962 aura 1962 terra nostra 1975 and among other novels distant relations 1980 they analyze the visual arts in fuentes s novels diego riveras murals and world film chart and comment on the translations of fuentes s narratives into japanese and romanian and propose comprehensive readings of the buried mirror 1992 and personas 2012 fuentes s posthumous book of essays beyond their comprehensive and interdisciplinary scope the book s essays trace fuentes s conscious resolve to contribute to the art of the novel and to its uninterrupted tradition from cervantes and rabelais to thomas mann and alejo carpentier and from the boom generation to latin america s boomerang group of younger writers this book will be of importance to literary critics teachers students and readers interested in carlos fuentes s world embracing literary work

a mysterious object has been stolen from the british museum a group of religious fanatics intends to use it to give life to an evil creature using an old lost language that of angels adams a young priest together with the old chaplain martin will seek the help of professor thomas dee who knows enochian a language created by his great great grandfather john dee in search of a forbidden book they will begin this adventure that will take them through spain france italy germany greece the united kingdom the czech republic russia turkey

mexico and antarctica itself following in the footsteps of lovecraft and his myths they will seek the answer in the necronomicon and other grimoires that will teach them to close the evil portal they will come across characters like nostradamus rasputin alice crowley van gogh and merlin they will also delve into the mysteries of kabbalah and alchemy they will analyze the crusades the holy inquisition the cathars and the essenenes only the angels will be able to help them with their difficult mission that will take them through great libraries and unveil the mystery of the great cathedrals

el catálogo de los manuscritos poéticos castellanos de los siglos xvi y xvii de la biblioteca nacional de madrid es el resultado de más de once años de trabajo de un amplio equipo de investigación que se ha venido denominando genéricamente edad de oro y que se ha identificado con la universidad autónoma de madrid la dirección del equipo ha corrido a cargo del profesor pablo jauralde y el objetivo del proyecto de investigación no ha sido otro que la revisión minuciosa de todos los manuscritos existentes en la b n de madrid a fin de desentrañar cuáles contienen poesía castellana de los siglos xvi xvii aunque sean de letra posterior o aunque la poesía de estos siglos sea escasa o mínima en un conjunto de poesía de otras épocas también se cataloga cualquier manuscrito que tenga poesía de esta época aunque sea un solo poema y el resto no guarde relación con el asunto prosa ensayos documentos en estos últimos casos se cataloga íntegramente el manuscrito porque es la única manera de presentar los poemas en su contexto por muy trabajoso que resulte bien es verdad que en las entradas a lo que no es poesía no se han dado descripciones rigurosas por ejemplo con íncipit y explicit la misma fórmula rápida se ha empleado para poesía en lengua no castellana las entradas fundamentales de cada descripción son número de manuscrito título y autor descripción externa descripción interna edición y bibliografía contenido cada una de ellas se explica por sí misma pero quizá convendría decir que en el apartado bibliografía y ediciones se ha buscado una fórmula ponderada que informe al consultor del estado de la cuestión cuando se trata de un poeta de primera fila de modo que no faltará una vez terminado el catálogo al menos una entrada completa para cada uno de los autores esenciales y a esta entrada y número de manuscrito se referirán las restantes también se accede a ella mediante uno de los índices en ningún caso se ha intentado la exhaustividad aunque autores hay por ejemplo san juan de la cruz quevedo góngora que poseen una tradición manuscrita más rica y compleja que otros por ejemplo que lope en la descripción del contenido se ha respetado la ortografía del manuscrito desarrollando sin señalarlo las abreviaturas más comunes añadiendo acentuación y puntuación con criterios modernos las enmiendas y adiciones van entre corchetes nunca ha sido intención de los catalogadores el ir más allá de la descripción objetiva para iniciar un estudio de atribuciones porque de lo contrario como sabe quien haya trabajado en estos temas este catálogo no se hubiera podido realizar de modo que las pocas veces que se ha señalado entre corchetes alguna autoría evidente ha sido para apoyarnos mejor en el proceso de catalogación debe tenerse en cuenta por tanto el absoluto respeto de los catalogadores por lo que el manuscrito dice para quienes crean que las atribuciones es tarea fundamental como lo es pero de otro cantar nada mejor que brindarles ahora este trabajo con el que sin duda podrán ellos mismos emprenderla cosa que hasta ahora resultaba muy difícil hasta la fecha se han catalogado 10 000 manuscritos repartidos según indica el plan de la obra y se ha

realizado un tomo común de índices estructurade la obra vol 1 manuscritos 1 al 3 745 xxx 658 págs vol 2 del 3 746 al 3 950 xxviii 682 págs vol 3 del 3 951 al 4 145 xxviii 684 págs vol 4 del 4 146 al 9 998 xxviii 692 págs vol 5 Índices xii 724 págs

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
