in all the hustle and bustle of christmas preparations one often overlooks the meditation oasis known as the advent season advent is the four week pre christmas season of the church year that focuses on the coming fulfillment of messianic prophecy as well as our own anticipated return of our lord for the judgment advent means to come and is appropriate as the focus is on both the old testament believers looking for the coming messiah and new testament believers looking for the return of the christ this book contains sermons and meditations for this season as well as an explanation of the advent wreath and the candles within that wreath

the season of light is a guide for families households classrooms communities and parishes who wish to make the lighting of the advent candles a daily prayer for each day of the season from the first sunday of advent until christmas day the season of

light offers a brief liturgy that is based on the structure of vespers or evening prayer in the liturgy of the hours the lighting of the candles the lucernarium a reading from the advent scriptures petitions and collect and a final blessing the advent wreath is one of the most enduring customs of the christmas season rich in meaning the four lights of the advent wreath kindle our blessed hope and manifestation of the glory of our great god and savior jesus christ titus 2 13 it is a symbol of our faith that light and life will triumph over darkness and death that our hope in god s providence and love will never leave us disappointed with this rich tradition in mind jay cormier has structured the daily liturgies in the season of light as follows the lucernarium the lighting of the candle s the word of god in which a lector reads a scripture passage that reflects the advent themes of joyful expectation and the restoration of justice and peace in the dawning of jesus christ the light of the world and prayers in which the presider or leader offers petitions and all respond then the lord s prayer is recited and the final collect and the blessing including a scriptural blessing and a table blessing before meals are offered by the presider the structure and prayers in the season of light are offered as suggestions adaptions are encouraged for example families may wish to make the intercessions an opportunity for spontaneous prayers offered by participants groups with musical ability and leadership may want to incorporate hymns from the rich treasury of advent and christian hymnody those who pray the liturgy of the hours regularly might consider including the advent wreath custom with the psalms and prayers of the hours designed for all those who wish to make the advent wreath a daily prayer and part of their christmas observance and tradition the season of light helps christians celebrate that we are an advent people a people who live in the eternal hope and expectation of the ever burning light of jesus christ jay cormier is the editor of connections a newsletter of ideas and resources for homilists the liturgical press has also published his lord hear our prayer the prayer of the faithful for sundays holy days and ritual masses and the family advent wreath blessings and prayers

many years ago our daughter s kindergarten teacher gave her a beautiful christmas gift a booklet of scriptures and a numbered candle each day that december we gathered as a family and read the scripture for the day by the light of the candle and then took turns praying about the verses these prayers were simple at first thank you jesus for being the light of the world little voices would pray we continued this tradition year after year and as our children grew so did their prayers this became a time of praise and worship to jesus for his indescribable gift of salvation rich conversations about the true meaning of christmas developed into this devotional book at the heart of christmas is love god s love for us compelled him to send his son christ s love for us caused him to leave his home in heaven to be born as a little baby our love for jesus in response to his great love for us should lead us to give him our praise and worship not just at christmas but all through the year we are often so distracted that we fail to love god with all of our hearts souls minds and strength as he deserves this christmas give god the gift that he most desires your heart to prepare your advent candle you will need a taper candle a sharpie and a candle holder starting at the top of the candle number from 25 down to 0 in descending order you may want to put a dot next to each number and write the year and happy birthday jesus at the bottom of the candle beginning on december 1st light the candle and let it burn down until the first dot and number are gone as it is burning read the scripture and devotion for the day let one more number and dot burn away daily as you read and pray until christmas day as you countdown the days until christmas ask god to help you to fall more and more in love with him give him the gift of a heart full of love and praise our family is praying for you that god will greatly bless you as you spend time with him reading his word this christmas season
